Check if true or item is completed

	Applicant is a graduate of a Tillamook County high school or a current resident of Tillamook County. MUST Include proof (high school transcript or voter registration card or other form of proof of residency)
	Applicant will be a graduating high school senior or a resident of Tillamook County to be enrolled at any University, Junior College, College or Trade School, working toward an associate, bachelor, graduate degree or trade certification.
	Applicant will be a fulltime college or Trade School student (12 hours or more per quarter or semester).
	Applicant must be studying agriculture or a natural resource science or related field (i.e. horticulture, Trade School).
	Applicant must submit <u>TWO</u> letters of reference with the application.
	Applicant must submit a high school and college transcript (if applicable) with the application.
	Applicant must submit, in one page or less, their career goals in agriculture or a natural resources field and explain how their goals will benefit what we do at the Tillamook County Soil and Water Conservation District.
	Completed and signed application form is included in submission.
